## Wood Floor Sanding

- 1 Heavy duty 1.1 kW dual capacitor motor provides power for the most demanding jobs. The motor is totally enclosed, keeping it dust free and eliminating the need for motor cleaning.
- 2 Easy release latch allows the machine to break down into multiple pieces for transportation.
- 3 12.2 m gray, non-marking rubber power cord provides longer reach.
- 4 Quick release dust bag that slides on and off with a simple twist and pull.
- 5 Dust pipe allows for easy attachment of 3.8 or 5.1 cm vacuum hoses for improved dust containment.
- 6 Transparent molded plug has an internal light that serves as a power indicator.
- 7 Rugged cast aluminum construction designed for years of service.
- 8 Drum lowering lever allows for feathering.
